## Story Time:

Today our lesson can be found in 1 Samuel 17. This story tells of a young shepherd boy who took on a giant. It is a lesson of protection, courage, faith, and overcoming what seems impossible.

### Read 1 Samuel 17

Because he had faith in God, David defeated the giant. Do you know that if we trust in God with all our hearts, we can conquer anything? When we dress ourselves in the confidence that God loves us and will do anything to protect us we can conquer all things. God even gives us guidance in how we can protect ourselves from the giants in our lives, we can find this protection in Ephesians 6: 10-18.

### Story reflection:

- Have you ever been afraid, if so please share how you overcame it?
- What does it mean to have confidence in God?
- What can we learn from the story of David and Goliath?
- Where can we find the amour of God in the Bible?



**Activation:** Let's play pretend and let's dress ourselves in the amour of God. Let's dress ourselves for battle and be confident in God's protection over us. As you say this prayer on the next page, "dress" yourself, pretending to put on each item.



## Kid's Prayer
