We make choices every single day. It can start with the simplest things. We are faced with easy choices and difficult choices.

Story Time

The Bible story today comes from Genesis. It is the story of Adam and Eve and the time they spent in the Garden of Eden. They had the best life. But one day, they both made a really bad decision that changed their lives forever.

Adam and Eve (Genesis 3)

Adam and Eve lived a long time ago and they were the first people that God created. Adam and Eve lived in a beautiful paradise that God created for them. Jesus had to make many hard decisions, and every single time he asked God for help. When we have hard decisions to make, we must do the same and ask God for help. God will never let us down.
