Day 08 Fixing our eyes on Jesus

As we navigate these uncertain times we're living in, not knowing what is true and what is false especially in the media, where evil is being called good and good evil, where fear is running rampant due to covid, what are you doing to maintain a level of sanity?

Are you focused on the negativity around or on the One who holds the future? Does the unchanging truth of God's word remain your yardstick at all times?

John 16:33 I have told you all this so that you may have peace in Me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows, but take heart because I have overcome the world.

Colossians 3:1-2 Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honour at God's right hand. Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth. (Hebrews 12:1-2; 1 Corinthians 2:2; John 14:1, 27; Isaiah 26:3)

Day 09 Open Eyes, Open Ears, Understanding Heart

We are spirit beings with a soul, living in a body. When Adam and Eve disobeyed, spiritual death occurred immediately and we lost awareness of the spiritual realm. Thank God that through Jesus we can have it restored. In this season we need all the channels of spiritual communication to be open, clear and sharp so that we can receive accurate revelation.

Ask yourself; Do I have eyes that see, ears that hear, a heart that understands divine revelation, or am I limited to the natural realm? Ask God to activate your spiritual senses.

Ephesians 1:18-19 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which He has called you, the riches of His glorious inheritance in His holy people, and His incomparably great power for us who believe.

(2 Kings 6:17; Proverbs 20:12; 1 Chronicles 12:32)

1 Corinthians 2:9-10 eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him- but God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.

Day 10 I give myself to the Service of the Kingdom of God

We need each other as a Body. We were created for fellowship not isolation but we find ourselves in a place where we have to abide by the covid regulations of isolation and social distancing, of which we must. However, we need to be mindful of the dangers, like our love for one another growing cold! Philippians 2:21 All the others care only for themselves and not for what matters to Jesus Christ.

Ask yourself; is this where I find myself? Am I giving of myself to the service of the Kingdom of God? What matters to Jesus Christ? How can I give of myself without endangering my family and I? How can I be a beacon of light/hope to the world around me? What role can I play in advancing the Kingdom in this season? Allow the Holy Spirit to show you.

1 Peter 4:10 God has given each of you a gift from His great variety of spiritual gifts. Use them well to serve one another. Colossians 3:23-24 And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.

Day 11 Equipped and Resourced for Glory

Hebrews 13:21 May He equip you with all you need for doing His will. May He produce in you, through the power of Jesus Christ, every good thing that is pleasing to Him.

The Father has equipped us with the Holy Spirit Himself and made available every spiritual, physical, financial, mental and relational resource that we require to do His Will and bring Him glory (2Peter 1:3). He has made us carriers of His Spirit so we can display His glory wherever we go.

As Frontline Church, we're called to create atmospheres for breakthrough, restoring lives and transforming cities and nations. Ask yourself; am I connecting with the Power of Jesus Christ within me to do His Will? Am I co-operating with Holy Spirit as He works in and through me? Am I displaying His glory wherever I go? Do I understand my role? How can I get involved especially in this season? (Acts 1:8; Ephesians 2:10; Philippians 2:13; 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12; 1 Peter 2:9; 2 Corinthians 9:8)

Day 12 A People of Distinction

We are in this world but not of this world. For God has delivered us from the power of darkness and translated us into the Kingdom of His dear Son (Colossians 1:13). For He raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus (Ephesians 2:6). Therefore, Paul urges us not to conform to the patterns of this world but to be transformed by the renewing of our minds (Romans 12:2; John 15:19; John 17:14-18; Philippians 3:20)

Ask yourself; am I walking distinctly in this life? Do I rise above the patterns of this world, corruption, distortion, perversion, plagues, diseases, darkness? Am I functioning from the realm of God- freedom, love, peace, light, divine wisdom, truth?

Malachi 3:17-18 “They will be My people,” says the LORD of Heaven’s Armies. “On the day when I act in judgment, they will be My own special treasure. I will spare them as a father spares an obedient child. Then you will again see the difference between the righteous and the wicked, between those who serve God and those who do not.” (Exodus 8:22-23 / Psalm 91)

Day 13 I Operate Generationally

In the era we live, there’s a serious increase of lawlessness. The enemy’s plan has always been to desensitize the generations of any form of godliness over the years, calling good evil and evil good, so that when the anti-christ appears they will easily embrace him. As stewards over our children, it’s our God given responsibility to pass on our heritage of faith.

Psalm 145:4-7 Let each generation tell its children of Your mighty acts; let them proclaim Your power ...Your awe-inspiring deeds will be on every tongue; I will proclaim Your greatness. Everyone will share the story of Your wonderful goodness; they will sing with joy about Your righteousness.

Am I training my children in the way of the Lord? Am I a good example to them? Do I spend ample time with them to spot any infiltrations? Do I invest time in prayer for them? Am I embracing my spiritual heritage from the past heroes of faith and passing a legacy to future generations? (Genesis 18:19; Isaiah 8:18; Hebrews 11:13; Proverbs 22:6; Ephesians 6:4)

Day 14 Wilderness Experience?

A wilderness is place of intense experiences of dryness, of great trials and temptation, of danger, of isolation, but also of divine deliverance, of renewal, and of encounters with God. Many of us may find ourselves in this place especially in this season.

For all creation is waiting eagerly for that future day when God will reveal who His children really are (Romans 8:19). I believe we are in that time and God is wanting to pour out His New Wine (Holy Spirit) but we need new wine skins to contain. And for us to become new wine skins, the wilderness experience is necessary - for remoulding.

God is refining His church so that we can manifest His Kingdom, in order to usher in the great harvest. The church is you and I, and God is singling each one of us out, no more hiding behind others as this calls for a personal decision! We need to become a place of habitation for the Holy Spirit if we want to be part of those creation is longing for. (Romans 8:19-22; Mark 2:22; Joel 2:28-29; John 14:12)

Our response in the wilderness will determine our experience and outcome. Jesus returned from the wilderness full of Power (Luke 4:1-2,14). So ask yourself; what is the posture of my heart? Is it of total surrender even when I don’t understand? Am I willing to let the Holy Spirit (who is a permanent resident in my heart) take full control and direct my life? Do I trust God to fulfil His promises to me?

Now make a decision, then ask Jesus to baptise you afresh with the fire of the Holy Spirit for intimate fellowship and for Power to fulfil His purpose for you in this season. (Hebrews 11:25)
